Changes to entries	Up until the 7nd of June 2008 is it possible to change your entry details via our website. Late changes will only be dealt with on the day of your tournament.
Program	All judoschools receive 2 weeks before the tournament a mail with the day program.
Tournament-ticket	All judoka receive on the day of the tournament a ticket to use for the official weigh-in.
Weigh-in	Weighing in is compulsory. The weighing scales have been controlled and will be final. All competitors must have a valid judo passport and proof of payment. The first weigh-in is for boys under 15 years (1995 / 1996 / 1997) from 08:00 till 08:45. The age categories U17, U20 and adults start in the afternoon.
Trainers	Only 1 trainers pass will be allowed per 8 competitors, with a maximum of 4 per school. Only coaching in a sporting manner will be permitted.
Prizes	Per pool there are 3 prizes. All other competitors will recieve a commemoration prize.
Challenge Cup	There is a Challenge Cup and the top three teams will receive an extra large trophy. The prize winners from each pool will earn 5, 3 and 1 points respectively.
