Official weigh-in will be held on the day of the competition according to the programme. Each athlete must present their passport or identity card.

DRAW

Computerised draw on the day of the competition. If a team has 3 or more competitors in one weight category, the coach may come to the main desk prior to the draw and assign the two seeded players who will then be put on the opposite sides of the draw table.

MEDAL CEREMONY

The medal ceremony for each age group will take place 15 minutes after the last fights in that group.

All athletes must come to the medal podium wearing a judogi.

AWARDS AND PRIZES

The first three athletes in each category will receive medals; the winners will also receive practical awards.

The best male and female judoka by judges' decision in each age category will receive trophies.

The best five teams will receive trophies.
