

## 5. PARTICIPATION / COMPETITION MODE

- Competitors should have valid medical certificate and accident insurance.
- Competition will be carried out on 3 tatami 7 m x 7 m, according to the rules and sporting codes of Polish Iudo Association.

# 6. AGE, JUDO GRADES, DURATION OF CONTEST

- Participants must be born between 2005 and 2007.
- Judo grade: 3 kyu and above.
- Duration of contest: 4 minutes + GS without the limit.

### 7. WEIGHT CATEGORIES

- Women: -40 kg, -44 kg, -48 kg, -52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg
- **Men**: -46 kg, -50 kg, -55 kg, -60 kg, -66 kg, -73 kg, -81 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg

# 8. REGISTRATION (until 22nd November 2022)

- Registration of participants must be made at least 5 days prior to the competition via this file sent by email <a href="mailto:zawody@pzjudo.pl">zawody@pzjudo.pl</a> (23:59 22.11.2022).
- Changes or cancellations can be made till 16:00 26th Nov via email <a href="mailto:zawody@pzjudo.pl">zawody@pzjudo.pl</a> or at the accreditation on 26th Nov 19:30–20:30 with Competition Manager.
- Entry made after the deadline (23-26.11.2022) = higher entry fee (40 EUR) paid before the end of accreditation (PJA Rules).

## 9. REGISTRATION FEE

- 20 EUR per participant (40 EUR if late entry).

- Please send confirmation of payment of the entry fee to <u>klub@judotigers.pl</u> together with the list of players who have been entered for the tournament and the invoice details (if required). This facilitates the verification of entries, i.e. the smooth running of the tournament!

## 10. WEIGH-IN, WEIGHT TOLERANCE

- Athletes can weigh themselves only once at an official weigh-in.
- Athletes must present his/her passport (National ID Card showing nationality, picture, and date of birth are also accepted).
- The official weigh in and random weight checks will be carried out according to the schedule (see the program).
- Athletes must wear underwear only (men briefs, women briefs and bra). All headgear, watches, glasses, socks, jewelry, and body piercings must be removed.
- There will be no weight tolerance. It is not permitted to weigh athletes without underwear. In order to compensate for the extra clothing, an additional 100 g weight limit is imposed.

## 12. REFEREEING

- Refereeing in accordance with the current IJF rules.
- All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches and Dress Code.

## 15. JUDOGI

- In cadets competitions, the competitor listed second may wear a white judogi and a red belt. If both athletes are fighting in white judogi, the athlete listed first will additionally wear a white belt.
- Judogi control takes place according to Sokuteiki rules described in point 5.1.2 of the PJA on Sporting Regulations.
- White judogi are required for decoration.

### 16. AWARDS

• For places 1-3: medals and diplomas.

## 17. OTHER INFORMATION

- Athletes must have personal accident insurance. It is the responsibility of the clubs to provide insurance for competition participants.
- Competitors must have a valid medical examination according to current regulations. The validity of the medical examination is the responsibility of the athlete or, in the case of a minor athlete, his parent or legal guardian. It is the club's responsibility to verify the validity of the examination.
- The organizer is not responsible for events outside the competition regulations.

## 18. BASIC RULES OF PARTICIPATION

All participants of the competition – clubs, coaches, officials, and athletes must accept and respect representatives of Polish Judo Association, statutes of Polish Judo Association, Rules and Sporting Codes of Polish Judo Association, IJF refereeing rules and POLADA Antidoping rules. Individuals recognized as acting against these rules may be suspended or expelled from the event.
